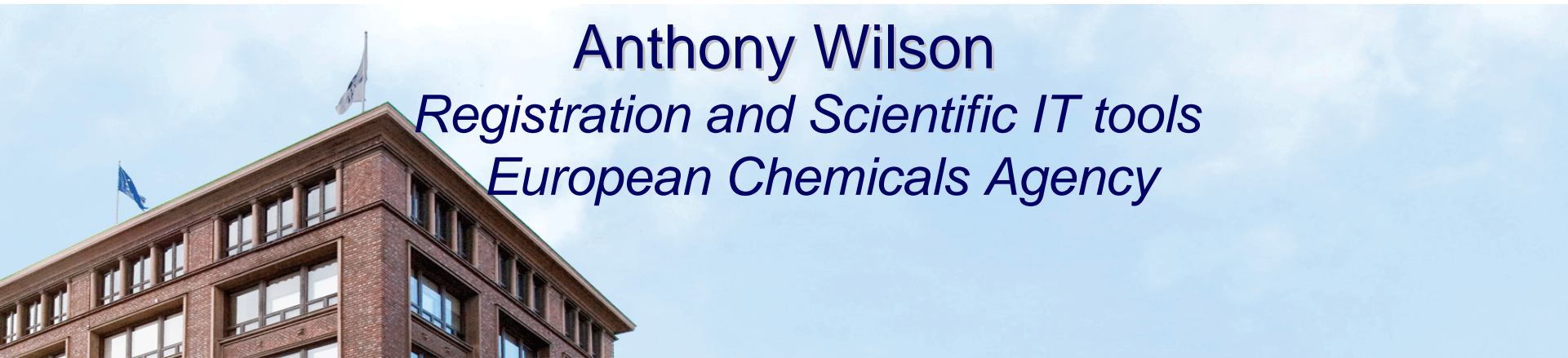

- One SIEF for each substance and one Joint Submission for each SIEF

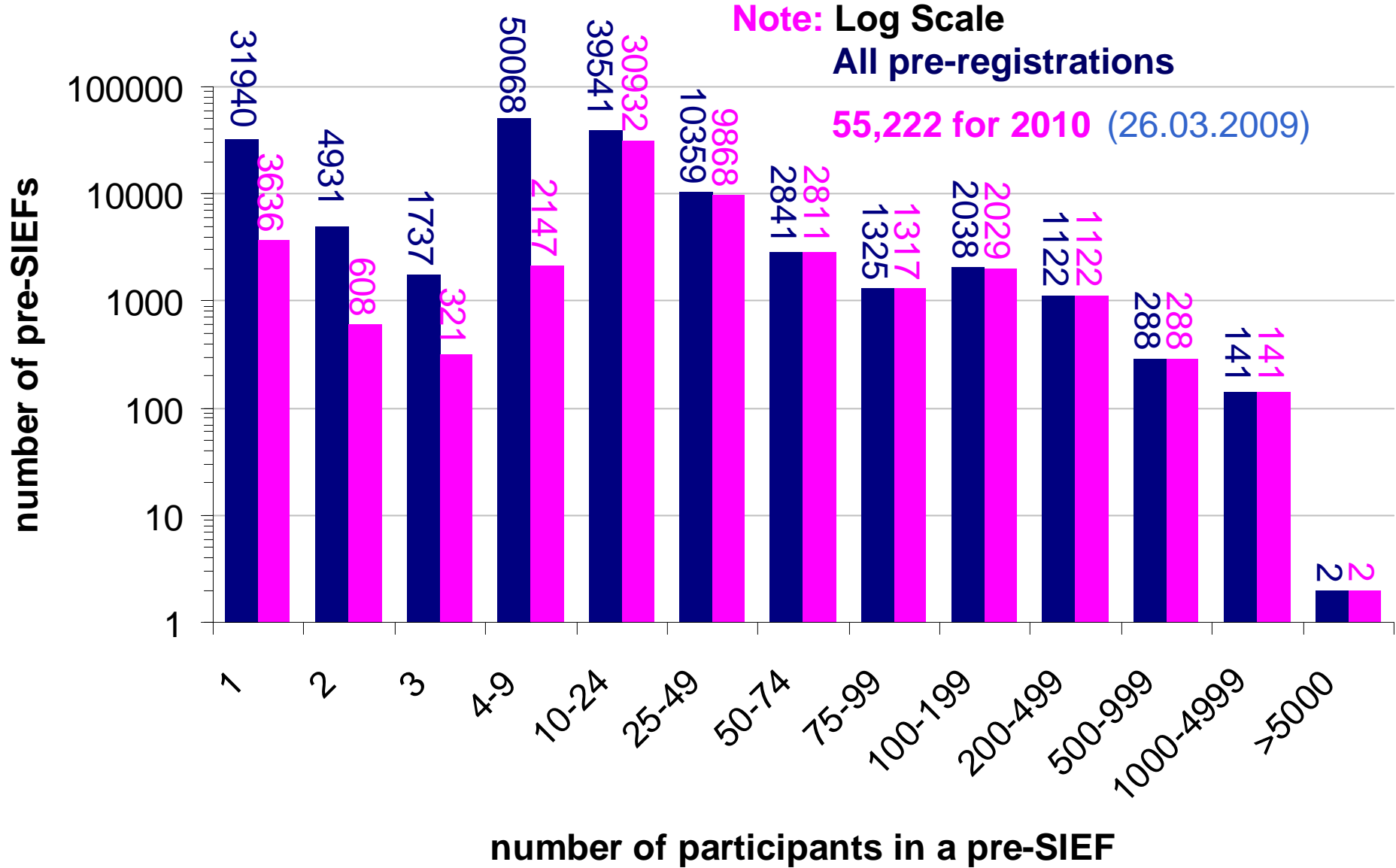
Timethe clock is ticking.....

Pre-registration to pre-SIEF

- At the end of pre-registration
 - 2 750 000 pre-registrations
 - 65 000 companies
 - 146 000 substances pre-registered
- The list of substances
 - Published 19 December, updated 27 March
 - Information from data holders
 - First time manufacturers or importers can “late pre-register”
 - If you made an error it might help you to find the right pre-SIEF
- Starting from a pre-SIEF
 - REACH-IT brings companies that pre-registered the “same” substance together in a “pre-SIEF” webpage
 - You can see contact details of other pre-registrants and data holders
 - You can start to look for “similar to” substances

So why the concern?

pre-SIEF to SIEF

What a SIEF is for

Formed by companies intending to register the same substance

Facilitate data sharing, avoid duplication of studies

Provide each other with existing studies

“Collectively identify needs” for further studies

Arrange for them to be carried out

Agree classification and labelling

Sameness: Are you in the right pre-SIEF?

Splitting or merging of pre-SIEFs

One substance one registration

Document what you do

Time*the clock is ticking*.....

SIEF Formation Facilitators

Allow a volunteer to initiate the SIEF
to encourage companies to work together

If it isn't working – deliver or step down

Members ask SFF to give up role and set a deadline

Work round them

Non-responding members

contact by e-mail and fax, perhaps use a website

make a reasonable attempt to encourage an active contribution

Non-responding members may choose to be active later

but.... those who want to be active also need a chance to deliver

Remember.....document what you do

Working in your SIEF

- SIEF members **MUST**
 - Select a Lead Registrant
 - Agree upon how they will work together
- Working in consortia
 - Good way of working in small groups on specific issues
 - Still must data share with other SIEF members
- Data sharing, costs and ownership
 - Technical discussion and communication
 - Reach Regulation Article 30
- Opt out
 - Companies may opt out of parts of the Joint Submission
 - Need to justify their action
 - Higher fee and evaluation priority
- Document what you do

Timethe clock is ticking.....

The Key Messages

Form or join your SIEF
Select a lead registrant

If your SIEF needs to register by 2010 it should be formed and have a lead registrant by the end of summer 2009

Submit your registrations by the deadline

Early Joint Submissions so other registrants have something to refer to

All dossiers for 2010 before the 1 December deadline

One SIEF for each substance and one Joint Submission for each SIEF
