# SIEF formation: 1<sup>st</sup> Survey

- Survey sent by SFF
- Identification of role in SIEF (SIEF code)
- Posting of note in SFF box in REACH-IT
- Feedback of results to all pre-SIEF members
- Learned to send attachment in older MS Office version

# SIEF formation: 2<sup>nd</sup> Survey

- Proposed SIEF organisation
- Substance Identity Profile (SIP)
- **LR vote**
- Call for animal data

# SIEF formation: 2<sup>nd</sup> Survey cont'd

- High level SIEF operating rules
  - SIEF management compensation
  - (Robust) Study Summary preparation
  - IUCLID 5 preparation and compensation
  - Preferably standard amounts
- Planning and communication
- Duties of SIEF members
  - E.g. modify contact details in REACH-IT

# Results 2<sup>nd</sup> survey: Process

- Started with 2010 substances
- Responses automatically rolled into MS Access data base
- Confirmation received that Eastman is LR
- Agreement on SIP content

# Results 2<sup>nd</sup> survey: Activity level

- Used to determine SIEF Leadership Team (SLT)
- Confirmation of earlier survey on SIEF code
- Percentage of respondents usually <20%
- # OF LE's interested in registration: Back to original ECHA/COM assumptions

## Next steps

- Survey for 2010 substances within consortia (July)
- Survey for 2013 substances (September)
  - Someone else requires 2010 registration?
- Form SLT (September/October)
- Formal data call (September)
- Support Cefic in finalizing standard SIEF operational rules (September/October)

# Critical industry deliverables: Standard operations

- SIEF operating rules
- SIEF agreement(s)
  - Available on Cefic website since June
  - Agreements on data sharing available in draft
- Setting up of invoicing system
  - Separate data management related funds from LR funds
  - Fair---→ Reimbursement over entire SIEF life
  - Prevent sending of actual invoices

# Communication with SIEF: REACH-IT

## ■ Use SFF box as communications tool that LR has been appointed

Dear Pre-Registrants,

Eastman Chemical B.V. has been appointed Lead Registrant for dibutyl terephthalate (CASRN 1962-75-0; EINECS 217-803-9). We intend to submit the full IUCLID5 dossier well in advance of the December 2010 deadline.

We have contacted all companies who pre-registered this substance by e-mail requesting to indicate their registration intentions and SIEF code with reference to the CEFIC recommendations issued in January 2009 ([www.cefic.org](http://www.cefic.org)). Results of the survey can be found on the relevant page in SIEFreach.

By follow up survey in July 2009 the Substance Identity Profile was approved as well as the appointment of Eastman Chemical as the Lead Registrant.

We will use SIEFreach to communicate with the SIEF code 1 and 2.

We also plan to document progress in the SIEF on our company website [www.eastman.com](http://www.eastman.com)
